He also lectured Sociology of Culture on private university Edward Berneys.

He is currently teaching Sociology of information society and cyber culture at Algebra School in Zagreb. In addition, professor Milardović is lecturing Political marketing for postgraduate students at Faculty of Economy, University of Osijek. He is the author of two textbooks on Introduction to political science as well as numerous other books on the subject of political science. In addition, Mr. Milardović published various research papers, articles and commentaries in both Croatian and foreign media. He is the founder of political science publishing house Pan Liber, Department of political science at Matrix Croatica, Research Centre for political science and Institute for European and Globalization Studies (I.E.G.S.) in Split. 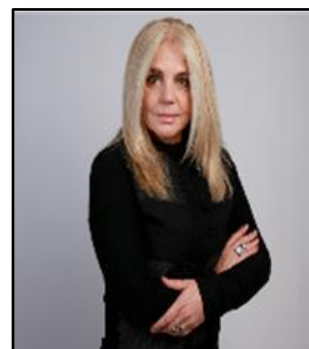
